

# CORANGAMARAH ART PRIZE – TERMS & CONDITIONS

## Conditions of entry

### Please retain this important information for your reference

- 01 Corangamarah Art Prize (CAP) is open to Australian and International artists over the age of 18 years. Entrants may need to provide proof of identification if requested.
- 02 Entry forms must be completed and returned by 5pm Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2007. Late and/or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Only correct money will be accepted and no change will be given.
- 03 Entry fees are not refundable.
- 04 Work/s must have been executed within the 12 months preceding Saturday 6 October 2007.
- 05 Works must arrive at 'Narroghid' 91 Harris Road Elliminyt VIC 3250 between 10am - 6pm on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> and Monday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2007. **Work will not be accepted after this date.**
- 06 All works must be for sale and must be the original work of the artist.
- 07 A commission of 40% will be taken by CAP on all works sold. For example, if the sale price of your work is \$1,000, you would receive \$600 and we would take \$400.
- 08 All two dimensional works entered must not exceed **100cm high x 200cm wide** (this includes the frame).
- 09 Every piece of artwork is deemed to be one entry. Each individual piece of artwork will not necessarily be hung next to other entries by the same artist.
- 10 All work must be fitted with an appropriate and secure device for hanging/installation. Velcro or double-sided tape is not acceptable. CAP will not be responsible for any damage to work that does not have suitable provision for hanging. Entries without an appropriate hanging/installation device will not be exhibited.
- 11 Work must be delivered to CAP dry. CAP will not accept responsibility for damage to work that is not completely dry.
- 12 Artists must take ALL responsibility for the transport of their work.
- 13 Artists wanting to document their work, must do this before delivery to CAP, as photographing work during the exhibition is strictly prohibited.
- 14 Artists who mail or freight their work to CAP must supply return (pre-paid & self addressed) packaging and arrange all return transportation.
- 15 Works must arrive at 'Narroghid' with clear details of the artist's name, phone number & title of work.
- 16 Acquisitive means that CAP will keep the winning work.
- 17 Works that are delivered by hand must be signed in upon delivery.
- 18 After pre-selection judging, artists will be advised of their exhibition selection by Friday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2007 via telephone, email or post.
- 19 The decisions made by the selection panel, judges and CAP in regard to exhibition selection, awarding prizes and installing work are final and no correspondence or appeal will be entered into.
- 20 CAP reserves the right to reproduce all work exhibited in the media.
- 21 The winning artist authorizes CAP formally and irrevocably to reproduce his/her work totally or partly in all publications and collateral used for this Art Prize including the official website. We retain non-exclusive rights to reproduce the winning entry for a period of 24 months from the time of the prize announcement.

## CORANGAMARAH ART PRIZE – TERMS & CONDITIONS

22 Artists are responsible for his/her own insurance cover. All care will be taken with the artworks, but CAP will not take responsibility for loss, damage or theft to artworks.

**23 The completed Works Submitted form, Entry Agreement and Payment Summary forms must be received by CAP in order for artworks to be exhibited.**

24 A photo or A4 photocopy of your original artwork must be included with your entry for pre-selection judging.

25 Artists are required to supply us with an invoice if their work is sold. GST is the responsibility of the artist.

26 Payment for work sold will be made to the artist upon receipt of an invoice and within 30 days of the closure of the exhibition.

27 Work cannot be removed before the end of the exhibition.

28 Works must be collected from Otway Estate Winery & Brewery, Colac-Lavers Hill Road, Barongarook, VIC between Monday 15<sup>th</sup> - Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> October between 10am - 5pm.

29 Artists whose work is not collected by Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2007 will be charged a \$100 late fee and an additional \$100 fee for each week the work remains at Otway Estate Winery & Brewery. All uncollected artworks will become the property of CAP after Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2007.
