

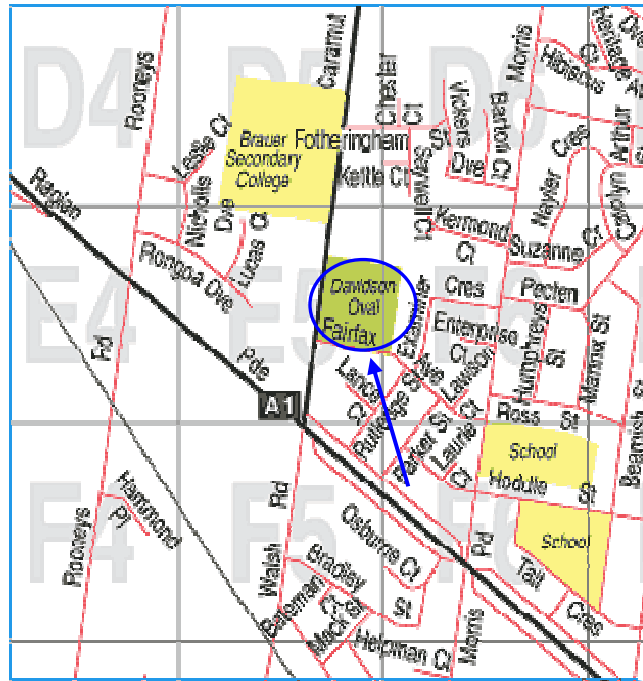

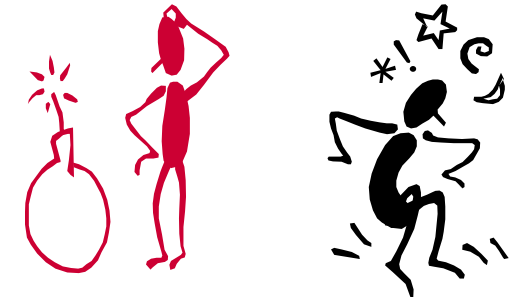

Agencies which assume responsibility for the understanding and management of persons with a history of aggressive / assaultive behaviour face an increased level of risk. This very successful workshop has been taught to hundreds of agencies in Australia, the USA and Canada.

The workshop is organised around a set of principles which collectively state that staff members who have developed a systemic approach to assaultive behaviour are less likely to injure or be injured during an assaultive incident than staff members without a systematic approach. - **RECORDING**
essential components of accurate & effective documentation.
