Colac Area Health offers a free & confidential financial counselling service to those with financial difficulties.

*Available at Otway Health fortnightly.*

**A financial counsellor can:-** Help you work out budget & payment strategies; Negotiate with your Creditors; Inform about gov services or benefits; Provide information about your legal rights; Show you possible ways to recover fines & costs or o'come legal action to repossess your assets; Refer you to other organizations that can help.

We also offer the Tax Help program to assist taxpayers with preparation of tax returns. The Tax Help program aims to provide assistance & education to low income people with a taxable income of \$40,000 or less. Colac Area Health provides an outreach service to Apollo Bay on a fortnightly basis. Appointments can be made by calling Otway Health on 5237 8500.

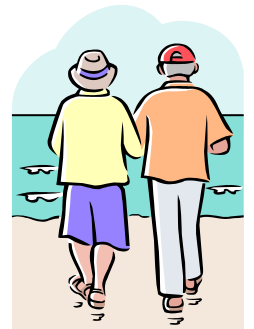
## **WALKING IS THE FIRST STEP**

## **TELSTRA BILL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

Assists consumer customers of Telstra that are experiencing a financial crisis and are unable to pay their Telstra bill.

An example of financial crisis is a significant decrease in income or high unavoidable expenses (e.g. a person losing their job, having high medical or hospital bills.) Another reason could be a personal or family disaster such as a fire, flood, death or major accident.)

People experiencing a difficulty paying their Telstra bill should contact our Community Welfare Worker.

Vouchers can be sent with a copy of a fixed line or mobile phone bill direct to Telstra to offset the cost of the bill.
